#### From the President

This week we farewelled Peter Bennett who recently passed away. Peter was a long term member and strong contributor in our club. This will involve a 'starter' on duty from 10:30am. They will tee off in the final group. A second person will manage the results having had an early tee time.

We are looking for paid staff for Fridays and Sundays. If you are interested in this role, know someone who is or would like additional information please contact me. At this stage the shop will remain closed on Mondays and Tuesdays. We are yet to determine our needs on Thursdays.

There are a number of additional golf events as shown on the calendar on the following page. These include three Sunday 'Golf and Roast' days and a Futures Family Day run by Aorangi Development Officer Tom Wilson. We are looking forward to strong support from members for these events.
